



HOW TO USE THIS PATTERN:

1. Print two (2) copies of the pattern: one to use as a stencil on the pumpkin itself and one to use as a reference image.
2. Secure the pattern onto the surface of your pumpkin and use a toothpick or poking tool to dot the outline of the pattern onto the pumpkin.
3. Now, follow the color-coding on the pattern and
 - a) cut away the parts shaded in black,
 - b) shave down, or peel away the parts shaded in gray, and
 - c) leave the unshaded/ white areas of the pattern alone.
